This year's Whatever the Need Campaign is a very significant appeal. Coronavirus has brought several needs to the forefront.

One of the issues coronavirus has created in India is food insecurity for the orphanages. Because India is still under some degree of lockdown, food has become very expensive and transportation to buy supplies is limited. That is why some homes have requested animals and others have asked for a car or motor scooter.

The other pressing need is for computers and tablets so the children can attend school remotely.

"I belong to a community where there is no safety for the girl child and there was no hope for my future. I thought that my parents will get me married and my life will have no meaning. Annai Scholastica Home for Children needs 2 cows, 25 chickens and 4 goats. Because World's Children donors gave their orphanage a wall, they can now have animals again. Food prices have increased dramatically because of coronavirus, so having some farm animals is cost-effective.

"After the COVID-19 pandemic the domestic hen egg rate is higher than before. Each egg is 50 rupees (67 cents)."

Not only can the home save money and provide high-quality nutrition, the children love the animals.

Bethel and Raichur Girls' Hostel also asked for a water buffalo to provide milk and cheese. The buffalo for Raichur has been funded.

Education Needs

Since all classes are being taught remotely, the orphanages need tablets, computers, projectors and TVs. You can see that WC donors provided a computer lab for St. Anthony's (right). Those children can work remotely. But not all the homes have computers or tablets for their children.

"Our children are attending the classes on line so we are in need of computers. Presently we have 8 children studying in classes 10th through 12th. Children are using staff mobile phones for listening to the classes. The timing is clashing and sometimes they have to forgo and miss the class. So we thought, it would be better to buy a few computers, so that they can regularly attend the class."
