Erasing Their Fears

Security is a huge issue at many of the orphanages. Men sometimes prowl the grounds at night. Snakes and scorpions are everywhere in India, and mostly come out after dark. India has 50 species of poisonous snakes—the U.S. has four. And an average 50,000 people die of snakebite in India every year—about five die each year in the U.S.

For those reasons, nighttime is frightening for the children. But thanks to you, their fears are now lessened. A total of 259 girls at two orphanages will have lights at night. And the 250 young women at Sacred Heart Nursing College will no longer be frightened when they return to their hostel in the evening after training at nearby hospitals. Now they will have solar lights outside their dormitory. The 76 children at **Fatima Home** will soon have a security guard 24 hours a day.
