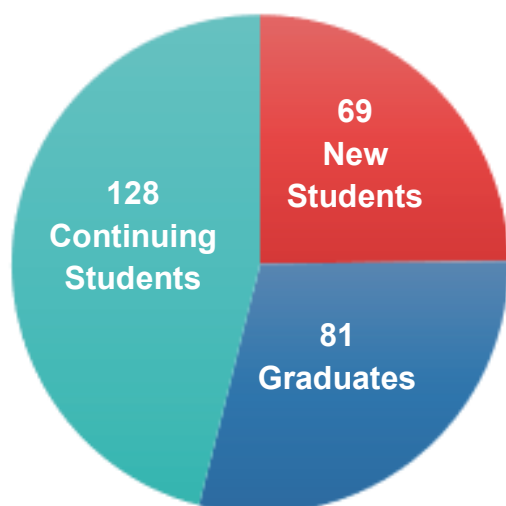
These are not easy times for the world. There is a lot of hopelessness afoot. But we should all take heart in knowing that we are making the world a better place, one child at a time.
